



Directions from the Calais Ferry Terminal

If programming a sat-nav: the town is Hallines, the gates are on Rue de l'Église, and the postcode of the region is 62570.

Reset your car's milometer to zero while on the ferry if possible. On departure from the ferry, you'll find yourself on the N216 following signs for [Paris](#), [Reims](#) and [Saint Omer](#). This takes traffic east along the coast, then turns south after about 3 km.

4 miles / 7 km from the ferry: You will come to a large junction, and as you pass over a motorway, take the exit signposted [Saint Omer](#), [Arras](#), [Reims](#), [Paris](#). You are joining the A26 (Autoroute des Anglais). After about 8 minutes you will see a road sign on the right showing that St Omer is 38 km away. That is the exit you are heading for.

25 miles / 40 km from the ferry: Come off the A26 at Exit 3, signposted [St Omer](#), [Arques](#) and [Lumbres](#). There is an unmanned toll here. The right hand lane accepts bankcards. Shortly after the toll, there is a roundabout. Take the second exit onto the D342, towards [Setques](#). It is also signposted [Esquerdes](#) and [Wizernes](#).

Do NOT take the first left turn to Wisques and Longuenesse, but after 1.3 km turn left just after the church, signposted [Esquerdes](#), [Wizernes](#) and [La Coupole](#). Stay on this road, the D211, as it goes through Esquerdes. After passing over a motorway you will reach Hallines.

At the crossroads with the traffic lights, turn right onto Rue de l'Église. Pass the church on your left and drive straight on for fifty metres. At the sharp bend, being careful and using the mirror on the pole, drive through the white gates.

Park to the left of the house, by the front door.
